- Diabetes has moved from epidemic to pandemic
- Estimated that 75% of GCC population may have diabetes by 2030
- > Approximately 25 % of diabetics will develop foot ulcerations
- More than 80% of amputation start with foot ulcerations
- > Diabetes is the leading cause of amputations in the USA

Key Statistics

- > About 20% of diabetics will be deceased within 1 year of a minor amputation.
- Almost 50% of diabetics will be deceased within 3-5 years of a minor amputation
- > About 60% of diabetics will be deceased within 5 years after a major amputation
- > About 35% of amputees will regain pre amputation mobility



Old treatments

- No longer standard of care
- Saline Wet to Dry Dressings
- > 0.25% Dakin's Solution
- Peroxide/Water mixture
- > Betadine
- Triple Antibiotic Ointment



Advanced Wound Care

- Cleansing
- Sterile saline
- > Wound Cleanser Shur ur Clens
- > Debridement
- > Sharp: : Scapel, Currette, Tissue Nippers
- Selective: Ultrasonic Debrider
- > Non Selectiveive: Maggots, Surgical Scub **Brush, Whirlpool**



Advanced Wound Care Dressings

- > Foam
- > Alginates
- > Collagen
- > Hydrogel



Foam Dressing

- Treat highly exudating wounds
- Venous Stasis
- Bordered and non bordered dressings
- > Polyurethane











Calcium Alginate Dressing

- Moderate to heavy draining wounds
- Impregnated with Silver (Antimicrobial)
- Impregnated with Honey (also paste)
- Non impregnated
- Control the drainage using material

Derived from Sea Weed (Hydrophilic)





















Collagen Dressings

- Mild to moderate draining wounds
- Impregnated with Silver
- Non-Impregnated
- Bind proteases within in wound bed
- > Made from cellulose, collagen, with or without Silver (Antimicrobial)













Hydrogel

- Dry to minimal draining wounds
- Made from synthetic material that are hydrophilic
- > High water content: 70-90%
- Can be combined with Collagenase for enzymatic debridement of wounds
- Collagenase used in wound with a dry eschar to wounds with a very fibrous base to remove slough
